AP Tests

The AP examinations are offered once a year in May by participating high schools that offer college-level courses based on AP course descriptions. Each high school that administers the examinations sets its own registration deadline and collects fees. Reports of AP examination results are mailed by The College Board in mid-July to institutions listed as recipients by students.

Students should list Baylor as the score recipient (Code 6032). If you did not list Baylor as the score recipient, please contact AP to have your scores sent to Baylor -- phone 888-225-5427.

The table below lists the AP exams that have been approved for receiving credit at Baylor. Note that the number of credit hours for each Baylor course is denoted by the second digit of the course number. Therefore, English 1302 is a 3-hour course, while Biology 1401 is a 4-hour course.

*Note change for the AP Macro- and Micro-Economics exams: The minimum required score is a 4 for students entering Baylor in academic year 2007-08 and after.

*Note change for AP European History credit: Students entering Baylor in academic year 2009-10 and after will receive credit for HIS 1307 only since HIS 1306 has been removed from the Baylor course catalog.

*Note change for AP Chemistry credit: Students scoring a 4 or 5 and entering Baylor in academic year 2010-11 and after will receive lab credit with the 1301 and 1302 courses.

*Note change for AP Physics C credit: Students scoring a 4 or 5 on the Physics C: Mechanics exam and are entering Baylor in academic year 2011-12 and after will also need to have scored a 4 or 5 on the AP Physics B exam to receive credit for Physics C. The Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism exam will not be accepted for credit.
