COVID-19 Student Guide October 5th

<p>AT HOME BEFORE SCHOOL SCREENING</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents/guardians are expected to screen their students for COVID-19 symptoms each day prior to sending their students to school. • Please do not come to school if you are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms. • If you become ill at school, please notify your teacher or nurse immediately.
<p>ARRIVAL / DISMISSAL</p>	<p>Students are required to enter the building through their assigned entrances below. Anyone arriving to school after 8:50 must utilize the Main Entrance.</p> <p><u>ARRIVAL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students must sanitize their hands upon entering the building. • Drop-offs before 8:30 AM are highly discouraged unless your child needs breakfast. • Breakfast will be held in the cafeteria from 8:10 AM to 8:40 AM. • Parents who drop off their students will need to remain in their cars. • Students will enter the building at 8:40 at their designated entrance. • While waiting to enter the building, students are responsible for maintaining social distance and may not congregate outside the building. <p><u>STUDENT DESIGNATED ENTRANCES</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cafeteria Entrance – Bus riders, walkers nearest to the cafeteria • Main Entrance - Students who park in the varsity parking lot, car riders & walkers nearest to the main entrance • Library Entrance – Students who park in the library parking lot and walkers nearest to the library entrance. <p><u>DISMISSAL</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be dismissed on the following staggered bell schedule: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ First dismissal bell – Release Band, Choir, Theatre, Wranosky Gym, 100, 200, 300 & 800 halls ○ Second dismissal bell – Release 400, 500 600 & 1000 halls • Students will exit the building through the exit that is closest to their last period class. • Upon dismissal, students must maintain social distancing and will not be allowed to congregate outside the campus. • Students must leave the campus immediately.

<p>PASSING PERIODS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All students must wear their mask/face covering during passing periods. • Students will travel through the hallways, staying on their righthand side, where lines are painted. • Students must always follow the traffic patterns designated by arrows on the floor. • Students are responsible for maintaining physical distances and adhering to established campus traffic flow in hallways.
<p>MASKS/FACE COVERINGS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students and staff will wear a face mask/face covering (over the nose and mouth). • “Mask breaks” will be implemented as appropriate and when social distancing guidelines can be enforced. • Students will need to provide their own personal face masks/face covering. • Face masks/coverings with designs and lettering must be appropriate and in accordance with the student code of conduct.
<p>CLASSROOM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When entering the classroom all students must wear a mask/face covering. A teacher can give you permission to remove your mask/face covering in class when they have determined social distancing standards are met. • Students must sanitize their hands upon entering their classrooms. • Teachers will monitor students throughout the day and refer to the nurse if symptoms are present. • Each student will be required to do the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Sanitize their desk or work area prior to leaving class. ○ Utilize safety partitions provided. • Students should limit the use of shared supplies when possible; shared supplies will be sanitized between use.
<p>WATER</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will need to bring water bottles from home. • Students may fill their water bottles at the touchless water fountain dispensers.
<p>CAFETERIA: BREAKFAST AND LUNCH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Breakfast and lunch will be served in the cafeteria. • Students must use their ID to purchase their breakfast and lunch. The keypad will not be available. • Food deliveries will not be accepted during the school day. • Visitors will not be allowed during lunch. • When entering and exiting the cafeteria, follow the signage, floor markings and staff directions. • Hand sanitizer stations will be available at entrances and exits of the cafeteria.

BUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will use hand sanitizer upon boarding the bus. • All students must wear a mask on the bus. • Students must enter through the cafeteria doors and remain there until they are released.' • Students should remain 6 ft apart and maintain social distancing. • Areas outside the bus lanes will be clearly marked and labeled.
EXTRACURRICULAR AND ATHLETICS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All extracurricular and athletic events will follow participation guidelines set by the UIL (University Interscholastic League). • All clubs and organizational meetings will be conducted in accordance with all safety protocols established by Flour Bluff ISD, UIL, and TEA.

Students choosing the hybrid option will attend FBHS on alternating days based on student last name. Students will adhere to their current class schedule and teachers.

- On days when students are at home learning remotely, they will login and participate with their teacher and class virtually from home.
- Wednesdays will be set aside for asynchronous learning with built in optional tutorials for each subject area.
- A teacher will be live to tutor students as needed.
